MASS MULTICULTURAL COLLEGE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION

The MASS Multicultural College Student Scholarship (MCS) is a component of Multicultural Academic and Support Services. The program provides multicultural students with a structured approach to develop meaningful experiences that will help them succeed at UCF and beyond. This scholarship is possible through the generous support of the Orlando Magic Youth Fund.

AWARDS

All scholarships will be processed through UCF Multicultural Academic & Support Services Office. The scholarship Committee will review applications, verify completion of requirements, and make recommendations to the coordinator of the First Generation Program for final selection and approval.

Grant funds will be <u>equally divided</u> amongst the total number of students who successfully complete the requirements. Award amounts are based on amount of qualified applicants and funds available. Awards will be processed after the posting of Fall 2015 grades.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

A) General Eligibility:

- ✓ Must be a Multicultural College Student (African American/Black, Hispanic/Latino, Asian American/Pacific Islander, Native American, Mixed Racial)
- ✓ Must be a **part-time or full-time undergraduate** student at UCF
- ✓ Must have a minimum term or cumulative GPA of 2.75

B) Scholarship Requirements:

- 1. Complete <u>10 MASS Workshops</u> by the scholarship deadline
- 2. Minimum of three (3) workshops should be taken in Spring 2017
- 3. Complete one (1) MASS Lunch and Learn
- 4. Complete at least two (2) Campus Experiences in one of the areas provided in this document.
- 5. Complete the MASS Multicultural College Student Scholarship Application. YOU MUST INCLUDE:
 - Current résumé
 - A list of all the MASS and Campus Experiences you attended (please make sure you keep track of each of the experiences attended)
 - Two (2) essays, no less than 300 words and no longer than 2 pages:
 - 1. **Biographical Essay:** Tells us who you are. Please explain some of the challenges you have faced and how you have overcome them, as well as your educational and career goals
 - 2.**Program Experience Essay:** How has your experience with the UCF Multicultural Program impacted you and how you plan to impact the UCF community through your knowledge and experiences
 - **Recommendation Letter** Must be issued within the current academic year. Preferably written by a UCF faculty or UCF staff member. All recommendation letters must be on department letterhead with the recommender's contact information and signature at the bottom.
